POLITICO's Matthew Kaminski joins WORLD.MINDS Executive Advisory Board

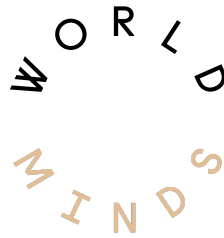
The American journalist Matthew Kaminski has been appointed to the Executive Advisory Board of the WORLD.MINDS FOUNDATION in Zurich.

Over the past decade, Kaminski has helped build POLITICO into a leading transatlantic media company. He was the founding editor-in-chief of POLITICO Europe, which launched in 2015. A joint-venture between POLITICO and Axel Springer, it quickly established itself as the most influential publication on EU affairs. He took the top editor's job in Washington in 2019, overseeing a period of unprecedented growth and journalistic impact. POLITICO's reporting on the pandemic, its "scoop of the century" on the Supreme Court's draft ruling to overturn abortion rights and its political coverage was recognized by the George Polk, Pulitzer and other awards. Since September, Kaminski has been POLITICO's editor-at-large, writing regularly on global affairs.

Born in Poland and raised in the U.S., Kaminski has bounced between both sides of the Atlantic throughout his career. He started reporting on Ukraine and other parts of the former Soviet Union for the Financial Times in 1993. He was a foreign correspondent, editor and columnist for the Wall Street Journal in Brussels, Paris and New York before joining POLITICO. He lives in Washington.
